All detainees are allowed 2 visits per week and two adults per visit. Visits are not to exceed 20 minutes. All visitors must show a valid ID and be dressed appropriately.

Shirt and shoes required at all times. Shirts must be able to be tucked in. No "spaghetti" straps, tub tops or sleeveless shirts. No mini-skirts. No hats, call caps, skull caps or du-rags. Attorneys are allowed to visit their clients at any time.

Immigration Bond Information for the Washoe County Jail

Delivery bonds (i.e., immigration bonds) cannot be posted in-person directly at the Washoe County Jail. Instead, family members or associates can post an immigration bond at any of the 82 ICE-ERO facilities around the country that accept immigration bonds. The closest facility to the Washoe County Jail that accepts immigration bonds is located at 501 South Las Vegas Boulevard, Suite 200, Las Vegas, NV 89101. The number there is (702) 388-6253. Immigration bonds can be posted Monday-Friday (except holidays) at this facility from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Bonds cannot be posted directly at the Washoe County Jail.

To post an immigration bond for someone detained at this facility you must have a money order, cashier's check or certified check. If the bond amount exceeds \$10,000 and over, you can only pay by single cashier's check or a certified check. All payments should be made to the "US Department of Homeland Security" or "Immigration and Customs Enforcement."

If you do not want to post the bond in-person yourself, you can also have a licensed immigration bond agent post the bond for you. For a small fee, ranging from 2% - 10%, an agent can post the bond for you electronically, so that you do not have to travel to the ICE ERO facility. This process is typically faster and easier than posting a bond yourself.

Frequently asked questions about the Washoe County Jail

Does the facility have public parking?

Yes. If you know someone who is detained at the Washoe County Jail in Henderson, Nevada and you would like to visit them, there is free public parking available at the facility.

Can I post a bond for someone who is detained at this facility?

If an immigration judge has set a bond in the immigrant's case, then yes, you may bond someone out of this facility. See the next question below, regarding the various locations where bonds can physically be posted and processed.

If I am bonding someone out of this facility, do I post the bond there or another location?

While you can bail someone out of the Washoe County Jail, you cannot post the bond at that facility. The immigration bond must be posted at one of 82 ICE-ERO facilities that accept immigration bonds. The closest ICE-ERO facility near the Washoe County Jail is located at 501 South Las Vegas Boulevard, Suite 200, Las Vegas, NV 89101. The number there is (702) 388-6253.

Nevada ICE Detention Facilities

There are three ICE Immigration detention facilities in Nevada. This includes:

- Henderson Detention Center
- Nevada Southern Detention Center
- Washoe County Jail

Not every detention facility allows you to post an immigration bond in Nevada. If you would like to post an immigration bond it must be done at an ICE-ERO facility that accepts immigration bonds. In Nevada there are two ICE-ERO Facilities where you can post an immigration bond in person. These facilities are located at the following addresses:
