

Immigration Bond Information for the Federal Detention Center "SEA-TAC"

Delivery bonds (i.e., immigration bonds) cannot be posted in-person directly at the Federal Detention Center SEA-TAC. Instead, family members or associates can post an immigration bond at any of the 82 ICE-ERO facilities around the country that accept immigration bonds. The closest facility to the Federal Detention Center SEA-TAC that accepts immigration bonds is located at 12500 Tukwila International Boulevard, 4th Floor, Seattle, WA 98168. The number there is (206) 835-0650. Immigration bonds can be posted Monday-Friday (except holidays) at this facility from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Bonds cannot be posted directly at the Federal Detention Center SEA-TAC.

To post an immigration bond for someone detained at this facility you must have a money order, cashier's check or certified check. If the bond amount exceeds \$10,000 and over, you can only pay by single cashier's check or a certified check. All payments should be made to the "US Department of Homeland Security" or "Immigration and Customs Enforcement."

If you do not want to post the bond in-person yourself, you can also have a licensed immigration bond agent post the bond for you. For a small fee, ranging from 2% - 10%, an agent can post the bond for you electronically, so that you do not have to travel to the ICE ERO facility. This process is typically faster and easier than posting a bond yourself.

How to get information on an ICE detainee

Please call the Field Office Main Telephone Number, (206) 835-0650. Please have the following detainee information available:

- First name
- Last name (including hyphenated last names)
- Any aliases the detainee might use
- Date of birth
- Country of birth

How to get in touch with an ICE detainee

Please have the following detainee information available:

- Alien Registration Number (A Number)
- Your name and telephone number



Frequently asked questions about the Federal Detention Center "SEA-TAC"

Does the facility have public parking?

Yes. If you know someone who is detained at the Federal Detention Center in Seattle, Washington and you would like to visit them, there is public parking adjacent to the facility.

Can I post a bond for someone who is detained at this facility?

If an immigration judge has set a bond in the immigrant's case, then yes, you may bond someone out of this facility. See the next question below, regarding the various locations where bonds can physically be posted and processed.

If I am bonding someone out of this facility, do I post the bond there or another location?

While you can bail someone out of this center, you cannot post the bond at that facility. The immigration bond must be posted at one of 82 ICE-ERO facilities that accept immigration bonds. The closest ICE-ERO facility is located at 12500 Tukwila International Boulevard, 4th Floor, Seattle, WA 98168. The number there is (206) 835-0650.

Washington ICE Detention Facilities

There are two Immigration Detention Facilities in Washington. This includes:

- Tacoma Northwest Detention Center
- Federal Detention Center "SEA-TAC"

Not every detention facility allows you to post an immigration bond in Washington. If you would like to post an immigration bond it must be done at an ICE-ERO facility that accepts immigration bonds. In Washington there are three ICE-ERO Facilities where you can post an immigration bond in person.

If you need an easier way to post an immigration bond for someone who is detained at an immigration detention facility, you can post an immigration bond through a licensed immigration bonding agent by calling (844) 910-2342. That agent can post a bond for you electronically for any detention facility in the US.
