Visitation hours at the Willacy County Regional Detention Facility are broken out as follows:

General Population:

Tuesday and Wednesday 8:00 AM – 2:00 PM

All visits must be 30 minutes or less. The facility recommends you arrive at least 45 minutes ahead of your scheduled time so you can be processed appropriate through security. All visitors must present a valid ID. Attorneys can visit clients seven days a week between 8:00 AM and 9:00 PM (including holidays).

Immigration Bond Information for the Willacy County Regional Detention Facility

Delivery bonds (i.e., immigration bonds) cannot be posted in-person directly at the Willacy County Regional Detention Facility. Instead, family members or associates can post an immigration bond at any of the 82 ICE-ERO facilities around the country that accept immigration bonds. The closest facility to the Willacy County Regional Detention Facility that accepts immigration bonds is located at 1717 Zoy Street, Harlingen, TX 78550. The number there is (956) 389-7800. Immigration bonds can be posted Monday-Friday (except holidays) at this facility from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Bonds cannot be posted directly at the Willacy County Regional Detention Facility.

To post an immigration bond for someone detained at this facility you must have a money order, cashier's check or certified check. If the bond amount exceeds \$10,000 and over, you can only pay by single cashier's check or a certified check. All payments should be made to the "US Department of Homeland Security" or "Immigration and Customs Enforcement."

If you do not want to post the bond in-person yourself, you can also have a licensed immigration bond agent post the bond for you. For a small fee, ranging from 2% - 10%, an agent can post the bond for you electronically, so that you do not have to travel to the ICE ERO facility. This process is typically faster and easier than posting a bond yourself.

Frequently asked questions about the Willacy County Regional Detention Facility

Does the facility have public parking?

Yes. If you know someone who is detained at Willacy County Regional Detention Facility in Raymondville, Texas and you would like to visit them, there is free parking available at the facility.

Can I post a bond for someone who is detained at this facility?

If an immigration judge has set a bond in the immigrant's case, then yes, you may bond someone out of this facility. See the next question below, regarding the various locations where bonds can physically be posted and processed.

If I am bonding someone out of this facility, do I post the bond there or another location?

While you can bail someone out of the Willacy County Regional Detention Facility, you cannot post the bond at that facility. The immigration bond must be posted at one of 82 ICE-ERO facilities that accept immigration bonds. The closest facility to the Willacy County Regional Detention Facility that accepts immigration bonds is located at 1717 Zoy Street, Harlingen, TX 78550. The number there is (956) 389-7800.
