All detainees must provide a list of visitors before they arrive. You should always plan on arriving at least 45 minutes before the scheduled visitation time so you can be processed appropriately through security. All visitors must show a valid ID and visits are not to exceed 30 minutes.

Attorneys are allowed to visit their clients daily from 7:00 AM to 9:30 PM.

### **Immigration Bond Information for the Bergen County Jail**

Delivery bonds (i.e., immigration bonds) cannot be posted in-person directly at the Bergen County Jail. Instead, family members or associates can post an immigration bond at any of the 82 ICE-ERO facilities around the country that accept immigration bonds. The closest facility to the Bergen County Jail that accepts immigration bonds is located at 970 Broad Street, 11th Floor, Newark, NJ 07102. The number there is (973) 645-3666. Immigration bonds can be posted Monday-Friday (except holidays) at this facility from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Bonds cannot be posted directly at the Bergen County Jail.

To post an immigration bond for someone detained at this facility you must have a money order, cashier's check or certified check. If the bond amount exceeds \$10,000 and over, you can only pay by single cashier's check or a certified check. All payments should be made to the "US Department of Homeland Security" or "Immigration and Customs Enforcement."

If you do not want to post the bond in-person yourself, you can also have a licensed immigration bond agent post the bond for you. For a small fee, ranging from 2% - 10%, an agent can post the bond for you electronically, so that you do not have to travel to the ICE ERO facility. This process is typically faster and easier than posting a bond yourself.

## Frequently asked questions about the Bergen County Jail

#### Does the facility have public parking?

Yes. If you know someone who is detained at the Bergen County Jail in Hackensack, New Jersey and you would like to visit them, there is public parking adjacent to the facility.

#### Can I post a bond for someone who is detained at this facility?

If a bond has been set then yes, you may bond someone out who is being detained at this facility. See the next question below, regarding the various locations where bonds can be processed.

#### If I am bonding someone out of this facility, do I post the bond there or another location?

While you can bail someone out of the Bergen County Jail, you cannot post the bond at that facility. The immigration bond must be posted at one of 82 ICE-ERO facilities that accept immigration bonds. The closest ICE-ERO facility near the Bergen County Jail is located at 970 Broad Street, 11th Floor, Newark, NJ 07102. The number there is (973) 645-3666.

## **New Jersey ICE Detention Facilities**

There are six ICE Immigration detention facilities in New Jersey. This includes:

Not every detention facility allows you to post an immigration bond in New Jersey. If you would like to post an immigration bond it must be done at an ICE-ERO facility that accepts immigration bonds. In New Jersey there is one ICE-ERO Facility where you can post an immigration bond in person. This facility is located at the following address:
