All visitors must be submitted to an approved list before they will be allowed to visit. You should always plan on arriving at least 45 minutes before the scheduled visitation time so you can be processed appropriately through security. All visitors must show a valid ID.

Attorneys are allowed to visit their clients daily from 8:45 AM to 11:45 AM, 1:00 PM – 4:30 PM, and 6:30 PM – 10:00 PM.

Immigration Bond Information for the York County Prison

Delivery bonds (i.e., immigration bonds) can be posted in-person directly at the York County Prison. The facility is located at 3400 Concord Road, York, PA 17402. The number there is (717) 840-7771. Immigration bonds can be posted Monday-Friday (except holidays) at this facility from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

To post an immigration bond for someone detained at this facility you must have a money order, cashier's check or certified check. If the bond amount exceeds \$10,000 and over, you can only pay by single cashier's check or a certified check. All payments should be made to the "US Department of Homeland Security" or "Immigration and Customs Enforcement."

If you do not want to post the bond in-person yourself, you can also have a licensed immigration bond agent post the bond for you. For a small fee, ranging from 2% – 10%, an agent can post the bond for you electronically, so that you do not have to travel to the ICE ERO facility. This process is typically faster and easier than posting a bond yourself.

Frequently asked questions about the York County Prison

Does the facility have public parking?

Yes. If you know someone who is detained at the York County Prison in York, Pennsylvania and you would like to visit them, there is public parking adjacent to the facility.

Can I post a bond for someone who is detained at this facility?

If a bond has been set then yes, you may bond someone out who is being detained at this facility. See the next question below, regarding the various locations where bonds can be processed.

If I am bonding someone out of this facility, do I post the bond there or another location?

The York County Prison is both a detention facility and an ICE-ERO facility that accepts immigration bonds. That being the case, you can post the bond at that facility. The York County Prison is located at 3400 Concord Road, York, PA 17402. The number there is (717) 840-7771.

Pennsylvania ICE Detention Facilities

There are four Immigration detention facilities in Pennsylvania. This includes:

- Clinton County Correctional Facility
- Pike County Correctional Facility
- York County Prison
- Berks Family Residential Center

Not every detention facility allows you to post an immigration bond in Pennsylvania. If you would like to post an immigration bond it must be done at an ICE-ERO facility that accepts immigration bonds. In Pennsylvania there are three ICE-ERO Facilities where you can post an immigration bond in person. These facilities are located at the following addresses:

If you need an easier way to post an immigration bond for someone who is detained at an immigration detention facility, **you can post an immigration bond through a licensed immigration bonding agent by calling (844) 910-2342**. That agent can post a bond for you electronically for any detention facility in the US.
